Microsoft Word is the preferred format for notice submissions. Please do not send notices only in PDF format as errors may occur when converting to Word. Image files should be sent in JPG or PNG format.

Therefore, please send all notice submissions in the Microsoft Word format and a PDF version of such Notice only where there are signatures to be included in the notice submission (document). This applies to all institutions including governmental, financial and other commercial institutions. Additionally, for the security purposes of any financial information being sent, the institution's Information Technology (IT) personnel can lock the information as a JPEG in a Microsoft Word document and send the information to the Editor in that prescribed manner.

The Gazette Department reserves the right to apply its in-house style to all notices. Any corrections which are related to style will be made at the discretion of the Editor for reasons of consistency.

Deadlines

The deadline for submitting notices for publication in the principal edition is midday Monday on every week for all commercial and Government notices, in the week of publication.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 6(2)(a) of the Defence Act, 2006, No.10 of 2006, as amended, that the Governor General shall, on the advice of the Prime Minister, by Proclamation direct that the Antigua and Barbuda Defence Force or part thereof be employed in aid of and to support the civil authorities in securing and maintaining public order and public safety;

NOW THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, KGN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Prime Minister, hereby direct that the Chief of Defence Staff of the Antigua and Barbuda Defence Force shall, with effect from 25th March, 2020 employ such members of the Force as he considers necessary to aid and support the Royal Police Force of Antigua and Barbuda and other civil authorities in securing and maintaining public order and public safety until such time as the Governor General decides otherwise.

GIVEN at the Governor General's Office, St. John's, Antigua this 30th day of March, 2020 and in the Sixty-ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign.

PROCLAMATION DATED THE DAY OF MARCH 2020, APPOINTING THE PLACE AND TIME FOR THE EMERGENCY MEETING OF PARLIAMENT AFTER A DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY AS A RESULT OF A DANGEROUS INFECTIOUS DISEASE

Proclamation dated the 30th day of March 2020, appointing the place and time for the Emergency Meeting of Parliament

BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL A PROCLAMATION

Governor General

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 25th day of March 2020, the Governor General on the advice of the Cabinet declared a State of Emergency under Section 20(1) of the Constitution of Antigua and Barbuda, Cap. 23 as a result the dangerous infectious disease COVID-19;

AND WHEREAS by Section 20(2) of the Constitution of Antigua and Barbuda, Cap. 23 every declaration shall lapse at the expiration of seven days beginning the date of publication of the declaration unless it is approved by Resolution of both Houses of Parliament;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS KCN, GCMG, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby declare that the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda shall lawfully convene an Emergency Meeting of the House by Video Conference Link to be held in St. John's at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday 31st day of March, 2020 as the time at which that meeting shall begin.
