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That is the preferred method of communication for **all** correspondence (especially when sending Notices/information which must be sent in Microsoft Word format) to be published in the Gazette.

Pursuant to Regulation 5A paragraph 13 of the Public Health Act (Dangerous Infectious Disease) (Amendment) (No.6) Regulations 2020, Statutory Instrument No. 37 of 2020

IN ACCORDANCE WITH paragraph 13 of Regulation 5A of the Public Health Act (Dangerous Infectious Disease) (Amendment) (No. 6) Regulations 2020, Statutory Instrument No. 37 of 2020 the Board with the approval of the Cabinet hereby makes the following modifications to Regulation 5A.

1. Paragraph 4 – Opening of businesses and conditions

Paragraph 4 is modified –

(a) by repealing subparagraph (2)(e) thereof and replacing it with the following:

“(e) Hotels, Villas, Guests Houses, short term rental properties and other holiday accommodations;”

(b) by repealing subparagraph (6) and replacing it with the following:

“(6) Public transportation services may resume normal operations provided that the operator of the public transport and each passenger wears a face mask for the duration of the journey.”
