1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health Act (Dangerous Infectious Disease) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2021.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations –

“principal Regulations” means the Public Health Act (Dangerous Infectious Disease) Regulations 2020, Statutory Instrument No. 16 of 2020

3. Amendment of Regulation 5A

Regulation 5A of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting the following new paragraphs-

“17. Measures specifically applicable to the period 4th February to 25th February, 2021

(1) Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in these regulations, the provisions of this paragraph shall apply for the period 4th February 2021 to 25th February, 2021.


- (a) all church services and funerals, with the exception of State and Official funerals, shall be limited to a maximum of 25 persons;
- (b) no gym shall be permitted to operate or offer any services;
- (c) all prison visits are suspended.

(2) All previously issued protocols for the management of the COVID-19 disease shall continue to apply save as is modified herein.

18. Restriction applicable to the V C Bird International Airport

For the duration of these regulations, only approved and certified airport taxi operators shall be permitted to pick up visitors and residents from the VC Bird International Airport.”

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Customs (Control and Management) (Amendment of Third Schedule) Order, 2021.

2. Amendment of Third Schedule – Goods Prohibited or Restricted to be imported or exported

Part II of the Third Schedule to the Customs (Control and Management) Act 2013, No. 3 of 2013 is amended by adding the following to the categories of restricted goods –

“The importation of any vaccine for the prevention of COVID-19 disease caused by SARS CoV-2 except by the Antigua & Barbuda Central Medical Procurement Unit or under Special Licence issued by the Minister on the advice of the Pharmacy council.”
