1) National Energy Efficiency Building Code

Scope and General Requirements

C101.1 Title. This code shall be known as the 2018 Regional Energy Efficiency Building Code, and shall be cited as such. It is referred to herein as "this code."

C101.2 Scope.2018 IECC shall apply.

C101.3 Intent. 2018 IECC shall apply.

C101.4 Applicability. 2018 IECC shall apply.

C101.4.1 Mixed occupancy.2018 IECC shall apply.
