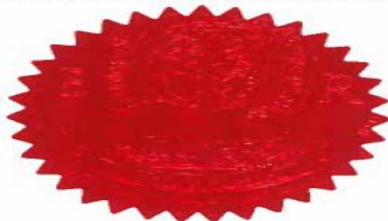
AND WHEREAS the 24th day of October, 2023 has been appointed as the date on which the by-election shall be held;

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
